

# HEALTH & SAFETY, RISK ASSESSMENT & FIRE SAFETY TRAINING

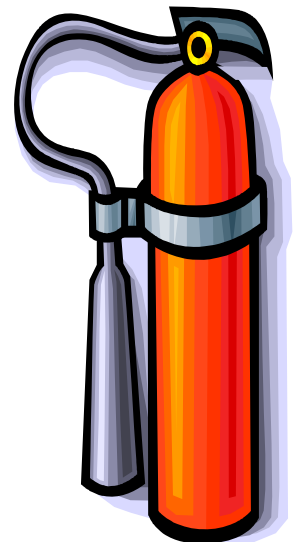
